- 1. Materials for administering the competition will be sent to the email address provided in the registration a few days prior to the November 2, 2022 contest date.
- 2. Prior to the date of the contest, make enough copies of the question papers for all participating students if needed.
- 3. Part I of the KSU Mathematics Competition must be administered during a convenient 90-minute block of time either during or after the school day.
- 4. Students must be monitored by a member of the high school staff at all times during the 90-minute contest.
- 5. Contest questions cover high school mathematics content up through, but not including, Calculus.
- 6. <u>No calculators</u> are permitted during the contest.
- 7. ESOL students are permitted to use a dictionary or electronic translator during the contest.
- 8. After the 90-minute exam, students' completed answers must be entered online by the student or the teacher.
- 9. Students may keep the question papers and should be encouraged to discuss the questions when the contest is over.
- 10.
