The university must have information about Non-Credit Bearing individual student or group travel that is supported by the university academically and/or financially.

For Non-Credit Bearing group international travel, please contact globalsafety@kennesaw.edu to request and submit a Non-Credit Bearing Student International Group Travel Form 60 days prior to departure. Accompanying faculty or staff leaders of Non-Credit Bearing student group international travel experiences are required to complete a program leader health and safety training.

Faculty or staff accompanying RSO group travel must do so on their personal time unless they have proposed a formal education abroad experience.

In the event of program cancellation due to health or safety concerns, undergraduate students who are present in their country of origin may remain in-country rather than return to the United States. Undergraduate students choosing to remain in their home country should communicate in writing to the Education Abroad Office

A laptop loaner program is available from UITS for travelers to risk-designated locations or countries with an increased cybersecurity profile who wish to leave their technology at home.
