For any question about whether a driver's license or state-issued ID card can be accepted for lawful presence verification, the Office of Enrollment Management & Student Affairs must be contacted.

- While driver's licenses and state-issued ID cards that do not meet the parameters listed below cannot be accepted for lawful presence verification, individuals presenting a valid Georgia Driver's License that does not meet the specified parameters should be accepted for lawful presence verification.
- A copy of the front and back of an unexpired Georgia Voter ID Card can also be accepted as evidence
